THE WINEMAKING

Rosso di Marchesi is a distinctive red blend that is a homage to Rudy Marchesi's Italian heritage. Rudy's grandparents, tended to and respected the land in their hometown in Northern Italy. They grew and produced their own food, made their own wine and thrived on a sustainable lifestyle. When they immigrated to the United States, they continued this tradition and instilled a love for the land in their grandson. Crafting this unique blend is a nod to them and to hearty Italian wines, yet with its own Oregon twist.

This is the seventh Rosso di Marchesi, hence the name 'Settimo Atto,' or Seventh Act. Crafted in the style of a red Italian table wine, this is a unique blend of Nebbiolo, Lagrein, Sangiovese, Pinot Noir and Teroldego. The Teroldego, Lagrein and Pinot Noir are grown on our estate vineyards, while the Sangiovese and Nebbiolo come from two well-respected vineyards from the esteemed Red Mountain AVA in Washington State. These varieties each offer pleasingly different characteristics in this versatile, food-friendly wine.

THE WINE

This is the seventh bottling of Rosso di Marchesi, our version of an Italian red blend. A unique cuvée of Nebbiolo, Lagrein, Sangiovese, Pinot Noir and Teroldego, this wine is smooth and earthy with plenty of dark fruit notes, like blackberry, dried blueberry, bramble and tobacco leaf. The tannins have gusto, making it pleasingly chewy and offering aging potential. It's tasty now, especially with wood-fired pizza or a plate of meatballs.
