2014 “Red Cap” Pinot Noir

Light orange-rimmed ruby. Dried cherry and red currant aromas show a vague medicinal quality and pick up a peppery accent with air. Smooth, gently sweet and focused, displaying very good energy and lift to the bitter cherry and licorice flavors. Suggestions of candied rose and cured meat build slowly on a long, sappy finish that's framed by gentle tannins. This is quite impressive for an entry-level Pinot, and for the price. ~ *Josh Reynolds*

2014 Reserve Pinot Noir

Bright red. Smoke- and spice-accented aromas of black raspberry and cherry pit slowly develop a musky herb nuance. Sappy and precise on the palate, offering sweet red fruit and cola flavors and a hint of musky herbs. Takes a turn to darker berry fruit on the long, gently tannic finish, which features a vanilla nuance that adds appealing, clinging sweetness. ~ *Josh Reynolds*

2013 Cataclysm Pinot Noir

Dark red. Vibrant, sharply focused aromas of red currant and cherry are complicated by hints of licorice and star anise. Sappy and energetic on the palate, offering focused red berry, bitter cherry and floral pastille flavors and a musky touch of rhubarb. Shows a sweeter character on the gently tannic and persistent finish, which leaves a hint of peppery spices behind. ~ *Josh Reynolds*

2013 Parsons' Ridge Pinot Noir

Brilliant red. Sharply focused scents of spice-accented red currant and cherry, along with suggestions of succulent herbs and rhubarb. Lithe and gently sweet, offering focused red berry and floral pastille flavors and a hint of white pepper that adds spicy bite. Taut and nervy, but there's good depth here as well. Closes gently tannic and long, with lingering florality; dusty tannins lend shape. ~ *Josh Reynolds*

2013 Graham's Block 7 Pinot Noir

Deep red. Highly perfumed aromas of black raspberry and cherry cola are complemented by suggestions of candied lavender, succulent herbs and star anise. Sweet and fleshy for the vintage, offering juicy dark berry and cherry flavors and a suggestion of spicecake. Tightens up and gains a smoky nuance on an impressively long, energetic finish, which features building tannins and a subtle floral pastille quality. ~ *Josh Reynolds*
